A word about the Delegate Rate: In order to keep costs down we have negotiated with the hotel a special delegate rate, which covers the cost of the coffees, biscuits and lunch. The delegate rate charged by the hotel is £22 per head and applies to every delegate whether having lunch or not. The District 105A training and leadership budget is subsidising this by £2 in order to reduce this to £20 per delegate which will include teas/coffees with biscuits (in the morning) plus a lunch with vegetarian and non-vegetarian choices. **Ask your club to subsidise or sponsor your delegates using the club administration budget.**
